

BY-LAWS OF THE REDLANDS NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

NAMES	The name of this Association shall be the Redlands Neighborhood Association.
PURPOSE	The purpose of the Association shall be to promote a better community through a group action. Specific goals may be established from time to time as the members decide.
MEMBERSHIP	Membership is voluntary to any and all persons residing within the Redlands Addition. The area is bounded by 142 nd Street on the north, 138 th Street and Pawnee on the south, Western Avenue on the east, and Arapaho Road on the west.
DUES	Annual dues shall be \$60.00* per household, and shall be renewable and be adjusted by vote of the membership to reflect the financial needs of the Association. Additional special dues may be approved by the membership to accomplish specific projects. *subject to approval
OFFICERS AND STREET REPRESENTATIVES	The officers shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. They shall be elected annually <u>by the entire membership</u> . A street representative for each street shall be selected <u>by the members of each street</u> . Any resident 18 years of age or older of a dues paying household shall be eligible to hold any office.
COMMITTEES	The majority of memberships in any meeting may establish committees for any specific purpose, to act in the best interest of the Association. Committee members may be appointed by the President elected by the Group. The standing committees are: Publicity & Communications, Membership & Elections, Beautification & Improvements, Security & Safety, and Special Activities.
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE	The officers, street representatives, and chairpersons of standing committees shall become the Executive Committee. This committee will meet regularly, call special meetings, take action between meetings as instructed by membership, and deal with emergency problems.
MEETINGS	General membership meetings shall be held on a regular basis at least biannually and at a time and place of convenience to the largest number of members. Meetings shall be called and members notified at least one week in advance. Each dues-paying household shall have the right to cast one vote at all general meetings and shall have the privilege of attending any committee or executive meeting.
QUOROM	A majority of the members present can approve any action.
AMMENDMENTS	The by-laws may be amended at any general membership meeting. Members must be notified at least one week in advance of the proposed amendment and two-thirds of those present and voting may approve the change.
